Please take note of the following:

Giving notice is a legal requirement for getting married or forming a civil partnership and your ceremony cannot go ahead without this being completed. Find out about the <u>legal requirement for your ceremony</u> and <u>make an appointment for notice of marriage or civil partnership</u> to complete the legal paperwork.

You can give notice up to a year in advance of your ceremony, but this must be done at least 29 days prior to your ceremony or 71 days (if you are subject to immigration control) and in the district in which you live.
